

COOKIE NOTICE

This notice explains how Europe Arab Bank (EAB) use cookies on our websites.

In this notice, where we say "we", "us", "our", "EAB" and the "Bank", we mean Europe Arab Bank plc. Where we say "our Website", we mean eabplc.com.

We will from time to time update this Cookie notice if we undertake changes in practices or supporting technology.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small amounts of data sent to your internet browser by the host webserver and typically support functionality or track usage. They are usually located as small text-files inside the 'Temporary Internet Files' folder on your computer's hard drive.

EAB may use the information we obtain from cookies in the administration of this website to improve the website's usability and for marketing purposes.

We use two types of cookie on our websites:

- Session cookies which are temporary cookies which remain in the cookie file of your computer or our server until you close your browser at which point they are deleted.
- Persistent or stored cookies that remain permanently on the cookie file of your computer.

How we use Cookies

When you use and access the Service, we may place a number of cookies files in your web browser.

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- To enable certain functions of the service and we use both session and persistent cookies on the Service and we use different types of cookies to run the Service including essential cookies: we may use essential cookies that may authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts; these cookies include:
 - Eab
 - PHPSESSID
- We use Google Analytics cookies to help analyse website traffic: information generated about website usage (including your IP address) is transmitted to the web analytics service and is used to compile statistical reports on website activity and user navigation and other services related to site and Internet use. Such services may also collect information about domain visitors' use of other websites, the types of technology our visitors use and help ensure that the pages appeal to a wide audience; these cookies include:
 - _ga
 - _gid.
